For Donors and Patrons of Tucson Osteopathic Medical Foundation Silent Auctions

- 1. **Tucson Osteopathic Medical Foundation (TOMF) Tax Status** This organization has been granted not-for-profit/charitable organization status under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Accordingly, contributions made to the organization may be deductible for federal income tax purposes.
 - a. All contributions must be supported by proper documentation.
- 2. **Donations of Goods or Services** TOMF's Invoice/Receipt includes a description of goods or services donated, and a <u>Good Faith Estimate</u> of the value, based on information provided by donors.
 - a. This <u>Good Faith Estimate</u> may not reflect the <u>Fair Market Value</u> acceptable to the U.S. Internal Revenue Service.
 - b. We encourage you to consult a tax advisor on questions pertaining to any difference between the <u>Fair Market Value</u> and the <u>Good Faith Estimate</u>, and deductibility.
- 3. **Donations of Cash** All cash gifts to TOMF may qualify as charitable contributions provided the donor receives no goods or services in exchange and has proper documentation:
 - a. If the amount of the cash donation is \$250 or more, the donor is required to have a written receipt from TOMF to substantiate the contribution.
 - b. TOMF will provide donors with a receipt for any cash donation.
- 4. Winning Auction Bidders When patrons of TOMF's silent auction win a bid:
 - a. For an Auction Item/Service at a price greater than its Fair Market Value:
 - The patron may be entitled to a charitable contribution to TOMF for the difference between the purchase price and the <u>Fair Market Value</u>. A deduction is limited to the excess of the amount paid for the goods or services over its <u>Fair Market Value</u>. (Ex: The Fair Market Value of goods or services = \$500; \$800 was paid, so excess = \$300 and may be deductible).
 - 2. TOMF's Invoice/Receipt includes a description of goods or services, and a <u>Good Faith Estimate</u> of the value, based on information from the donor.
 - 3. We encourage you to consult a tax advisor on questions pertaining to any difference between the <u>Fair Market Value</u> and the <u>Good Faith Estimate</u>, and deductibility.
 - 4. Retain receipts for your income tax records.
 - b. For an Auction Item/Service at a price lower than or equal to its Fair Market Value:
 - i. The patron will not be entitled to a charitable contribution to TOMF.
 - 1. TOMF's Invoice/Receipt includes a description of goods or services donated, and a <u>Good Faith Estimate</u> of the value, based on information provided by donors.
 - ii. Please consult a tax advisor on questions pertaining to any difference between the <u>Fair Market Value</u> and the <u>Good Faith Estimate</u>, and deductibility.
 - iii. Retain receipts for your income tax records.
